



BEHAVIOUR ON SITE

- From 22.00 to 07.00 all motorized traffic is prohibited on the site. The gate is locked during the same hours. If you wish to leave the site during these hours, please use the parking areas outside the gate.
- For the safety of children and pedestrians, the maximum speed is 5 km/h on the whole site. The speed limit also applies to bicycles, which may only be used on the designated roads.
- After 11 p.m., the site must be quiet.
- Your own car must be parked on your own pitch/unit, due to neighbors and fire roads. It is not allowed to park on "empty" neighbor"-pitches or on the common areas of the campsite. It's only allowed to park one car on each unit. Other cars are directed to the parking areas outside the gate.
- Charging electric cars or other electric vehicles and batteries at the site's power points, including electric bicycles, is not permitted. The electrical installations cannot withstand the load. Violation will result in a fee of 2000 DKK and the payment of any repair costs.
- When you move around on the campsite, please only use communal areas and established roads/paths. Do not walk through other people's unit spaces/pitches.
- Children's play in toilets/bathrooms and unrestrained cycling around service buildings is not permitted. Minors must always be accompanied by an adult in bathrooms/toilets.
- Children under the age of 15 must always be accompanied by an adult when using the swimming pool.
- Use of the swimming pool, playground and bathing bridge is at your own risk.
- The use of any kind of weapons and fireworks is prohibited on site.
- Trading on the campsite is only allowed with the permission of the camp director.
- Common facilities, i.e., toilets, laundry room, kitchen, etc., must be left clean and tidy after use.

PLACEMENT OF CARAVAN/TENT

- The caravan/tent must be positioned in such a way as not to impair the positioning possibilities of neighbors.
- There shall always be a minimum distance of 1,5 meters between the caravan/tent and the boundary of the unit site.
- Caravans must be mobile, i.e., registered to drive in accordance with the Road Traffic Act, or be provided with ID number plates.
- The camping wind breaks normally found in the trade may be erected - private fencing of the unit site is not permitted.
- Flagpoles, antennas, etc. may not be erected, and digging and pruning of plants/trees or the like is not permitted.

FIRE PROTECTION MEASURES

- There must always be 3 meters between camping units (caravan or tent).
- Barbecues and bonfires must take place in the designated areas by the kitchen building and the beach area respectively.
- Under no circumstances may large fires be built, and they must always be supervised. When a fire or barbecue is left, all fires and embers must be extinguished. During drought, no fires or barbecues may be built on the site.

WASTE

- The container area at the entrance must be used for waste.
- It is NOT permitted to leave items such as bulky waste, gas cylinders, used batteries, camping furniture, tents or similar - if this happens, the waste will be removed at the guest's expense.



PETS

- Pets are welcome but must not disturb other guests or cause unnecessary noise.
- Dog walking must take place outside the site. Please remember the dog bag for collecting dog's waste in case it happens on site.
- Pets must always be tethered or in secure fenced area. On the site, pets must always be kept on a short leash.
- Pets may not be brought into toilets/bathrooms, kitchens, other indoor facilities, or the pool area.

PLAYGROUND AND BALL GAMES

- The playground is reserved for children up to the age of 10.
- Ball games and violent play are not allowed in the playground or between tents and caravans. Ball games must be played where they do not disturb other guests.

DEPARTURE

- You must inform reception of your departure time as soon as possible, especially during busy periods on the campsite.

RESPONSIBILITY

- The campsite owner and the campsite manager accept no responsibility for damage to or loss of campers' belongings.
- Anyone who damages buildings, equipment or the property of fellow campers may be held liable in accordance with the general rules on compensation.
- Violation of the campsite rules, the camp director's instructions or the provisions of these regulations may result in expulsion from the campsite.

NATURE AND ENVIRONMENT

- Show consideration and protect the nature and environment - both depend on your protection.
- Do not litter - including cigarette butts.
- Waste must be sorted according to the site's instructions.
- Save energy and resources:
 - Limit water use when bathing - take short baths and turn off the water when applying shampoo and soap.
 - Limit water use when doing the dishes- don't let the water run, use a tub/sink.
 - Limit power consumption - Be aware of your power consumption and turn off the lights after you.
